This week is known as “Holy Week” for the Christian, the week leading up to and including the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ. It starts with the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem on what’s now called Palm Sunday, and ends with the celebration of Christ’s resurrection, commonly called Easter.
